

## Technical Update – March 2013

### FASTNET – ADDITIONAL CROPS NOW ON LABEL

The following crops have recently been added to the Fastnet (pendimethalin 330 gm/l EC) label:

apple, blackberry, blackcurrant, broccoli/calabrese, brussels sprout, bulb onion, cabbage, carrot, cauliflower, cherry, durum wheat, forage maize (grown under temporary plastic mulch), gooseberry, grain maize, grain maize (grown under temporary plastic mulch), leek, loganberry, parsnip, pear, plum, , raspberry, rubus hybrid, strawberry,

Details are listed in the table below:

DURUM WHEAT	4.0	1 PER CROP	BEFORE LEAF SHEATH ERECT STAGE (G.S.30)
FORAGE MAIZE (grown under temporary plastic mulch)	4.5	1 PER CROP	PRE CROP EMERGENCE
GRAIN MAIZE & GRAIN MAIZE (grown under temporary plastic mulch)	4.5	1 PER CROP	PRE CROP EMERGENCE
LEEK	4.0	1 PER CROP	PRE CROP EMERGENCE
CARROTS & PARSNIPS	4.0	1 PER CROP	PRE CROP EMERGENCE
BULB ONIONS	4.0	1 PER CROP	PRE CROP EMERGENCE
BROCCOLI/CALABRESE, BRUSSELS SPROUT, CABBAGE, CAULIFLOWER	4.0	1 PER CROP	BEFORE TRANSPLANTING
BLACK CURRENT, GOOSEBERRY	4.0	1 PER YEAR	BEFORE BUD BURST
STRAWBERRY	4.0	1 PER YEAR	AFTER FLOWER INITIATION BUT BEFORE FLOWER TRUSS EMERGENCE

Crops previously on the label remain unchanged: barley (winter & spring), wheat (winter), combining pea, potato, forage maize, sunflower, rye (winter) & triticale.
