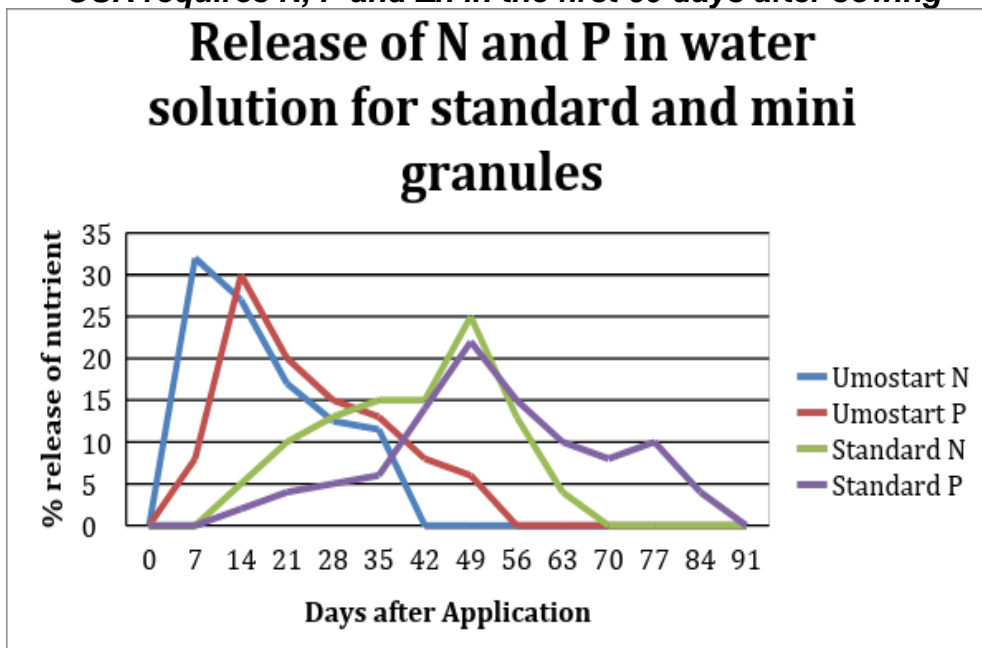


Technical Bulletin: Umostart for Oilseed Rape 11-50-0 + Zinc

- The arrival of rain in most areas is encouraging growers to begin drilling of oilseed rape
- Seedbeds are generally looking reasonable with moisture in the surface layers.
- Heavy rain may have driven residual N deeper into the soil profile
- Some growers are delaying drilling in order to minimise attacks by CSFB
- Later drilling makes it essential that the germinating seed has rapid access to nutrients which will help the roots develop and improve establishment

OSR requires N, P and Zn in the first 60 days after sowing



Umostart

- Can be placed next to seed for rapid nutrient uptake even in drier conditions
- Low rates of P and N -does not have significant effects on soil P level - environmentally sound
- Beneficial effects of applying N with P increasing P uptake
- 35% of soils tested were below P index 2 in 2017
- 26% of soils were below guideline levels for zinc
